



SERVICES AVAILABLE

- **Foster Care** is a temporary home for children needing out-of-home care due to abuse or neglect. Foster families provide a safe and nurturing home and are committed to working with birth families to reunite children with parents, when possible.
- **Therapeutic Foster Care (TFC)** is available for children ages 3-18 in need of extra care and attention as they await adoption or reunification.
- **Supportive Services**
Include: monthly training for foster families, special events, in home support from family specialists, individual and family therapy, educational support and advocacy, respite care, crisis lines, etc.
